- 2. The Terms of Reference of the Committee shall be as follows:-
 - To consider and suggest modifications if found necessary for the Pay and Allowances of:
 - a) Posts under Government service, including Part-time Contingent Service and Casual Sweepers
 - b) Posts including Part-time posts and Casual Sweepers under Educational Institutions of the Government, Aided schools and colleges and also such institutions covered by direct payment scheme excluding those posts covered by UGC/AICTE etc. scheme of scales of pay and also posts for which, Central scales

- of pay have already been allowed such as teaching staff in Medical Colleges, Judicial Officers, etc.
- Posts under Local Bodies and University employees except those posts covered by AICTE/UGC/Central Scheme.
- ii) To examine the present structure of pay and allowances and other emoluments and service conditions including promotional avenues and fringe benefits available to the above categories of employees and suggest changes which may be desirable and feasible keeping in view, inter-alia, the need for greater social accountability and efficiency of administration.
- To examine and suggest changes if any to the benefits available to Service Pensioners.
- iv) To suggest remedies for the anomalies caused due to the last pay revision and to suggest measures to avoid cascading effects if any, likely to be caused by such anomalies.
- To examine and assess the additional financial commitment for implementing the pay revision with effect from 01.07.2009.
- vi) While considering the above issues, the need for bringing down the wide disparity if any existing between different scales in Government service shall be kept in mind.
- While considering the above issues the need for a gender sensitive service structure shall also be kept in mind.
- The term of the Pay Revision Commission shall be 6 months.
- Sanction is hereby accorded for the creation of 30 temporary posts in the Pay Revision Commission 2010. Out of this, 18 posts will be from Secretariat Service and 12 from other Government Departments.

ADDENDUM

1. The second sentence in sub para (ii) of para 7.42.2 at page 285 of the report is modified as follows:

A post of Sheristadar each may be created in the MACTs at Kollam, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Manjeri and Thalassery and Wakf Tribunals in Kollam, Ernakulam and Kozhikode

2. The sub para (v) of para 7.11.3 at page No. 163 is substituted by the following:

Advocates who are eligible to be appointed as District Judges are appointed as Presidents of District Consumer Protection Forum on permanent basis for a period of 5 years. As per rule 15(6) of the Consumer Protection Rules, the Presidents are entitled to salary and allowances admissible to a serving District Judge. The Commission is of the view that the Presidents are entitled to all the monetary benefits to a serving District Judge.

After 5 years of service, the Presidents have to retire; but in view of Rule 14(4) of Consumer Protection Rules they are not entitled to pension. By an amendment to Rule 7 of the Bar Council Rules, they are prevented from practicing as Lawyers before Courts/Tribunals/Authorities equivalent or lower to the post, such officer last presided over. Thus they are prevented and cannot set up practice before any District Courts or other Courts of similar or lower ranks. This will cause much hardship to them after the term of 5 years.

After careful consideration of the request of them, the Commission recommends the Government to take necessary steps so as to enable them the grant of pension or some other Compensatory measures to redress their genuine grievances. It is further recommended to extend all monetary benefits i.e. the salary and all other allowances admissible to sitting District Judges.

3. Ex-gratia pension

In Chapter 11, the following shall be added as para No. 11.49 After careful consideration, the Commission recommends the following increase of Ex-gratia pension as detailed below.
